

## INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

*Scope:* The *American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery (AJCS)* is the official journal of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery as well as of other cosmetic or aesthetic surgery organizations. The printer is Allen Press, Lawrence, Kansas. Both original and educational manuscripts about cosmetic surgery designed for cosmetic surgeons in academic and community environments are included in the *Journal*.

*Manuscript Submission:* Manuscripts may be submitted to the journal online via <http://ajcs.allentrack.net>.

*Manuscript Preparation:* All manuscripts submitted to *AJCS* must be original (i.e. not published elsewhere) and may not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts must be prepared according to the "Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals" (available at <http://www.icmje.org>).

*Peer Review:* All manuscripts submitted to *AJCS* are subject to peer review and editing. Each manuscript is reviewed by at least two experts in the field who may also be members of the Editorial Board. The decision of the Editor is final. Authors are notified of the decision by mail, and any reviewer comments provided will be included.

*Authorship:* As noted in the Uniform Requirements, "All persons designated as authors should qualify for authorship. Each author should have participated sufficiently in the work to take public responsibility for the content.

Authorship credit should be based only on substantial contributions to (1) conception and design, or analysis and interpretation of data; and to (2) drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and on (3) final approval of the version to be published. Conditions (1), (2), and (3) must all be met. . . . Any part of an article critical to its main conclusions must be the responsibility of at least one author."

The Uniform Requirements also state that "Increasingly, multicenter trials are attributed to a corporate author. All members of the group who are named as authors, either in the authorship position below the title or in a footnote, should fully meet the criteria for authorship. Group members who do not meet these

criteria should be listed, with their permission, in the acknowledgements or in an appendix."

All authors are requested to indicate in a cover letter accompanying the manuscript that they are willing to take public responsibility for the work, have reviewed the final version of the manuscript, and if requested, will produce the data upon which the manuscript is based.

*Copyright and Financial Disclosure:* Copyright on all accepted manuscripts will be held by the *AJCS*. In view of current US copyright law, effective January 1, 1978, it is necessary that a statement be signed by all authors expressly transferring copyright to *AJCS* in the event that the paper is accepted for publication in the *Journal*. If the authors are or were US government employees and wrote the work as part of their official duties, they must indicate this fact on the form.

All authors will be asked to complete a confidential disclosure form regarding affiliation with or financial involvement in any organization with a direct financial interest in the subject matter or materials discussed in the manuscript.

The copyright transfer and financial disclosure forms will be sent to the Corresponding Author by the Managing Editor when receipt of the manuscript is acknowledged. It is the responsibility of the corresponding author to obtain the signatures of all coauthors on both forms.

*Experimental Subjects:* All authors are expected to abide by accepted ethical standards. In investigations that involve human subjects or laboratory animals, authors should provide an explicit statement in the Materials and Methods section that explains that the experimental protocols were approved by the appropriate institutional review committee and that these meet the guidelines of the authors' responsible governmental agency. In the case of human subjects, informed consent is essential.

### STRUCTURED MANUSCRIPTS AND ABSTRACTS
